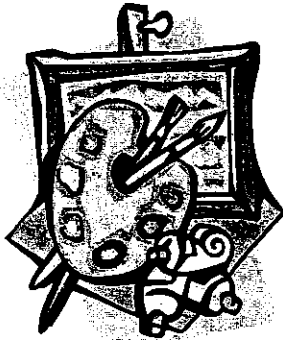
There will be a mandated ticket purchase of 2 tickets per family. Tickets will be sold for \$50.00 each. The evening is being built to be something new and grand!
