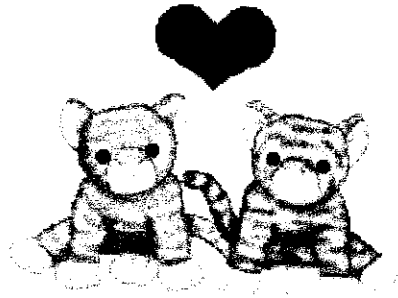
Big Events

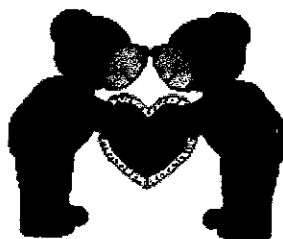

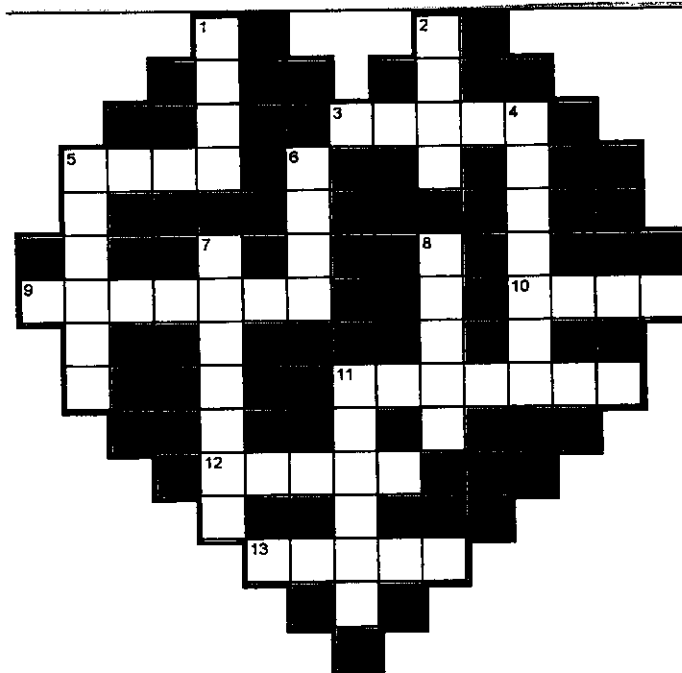
