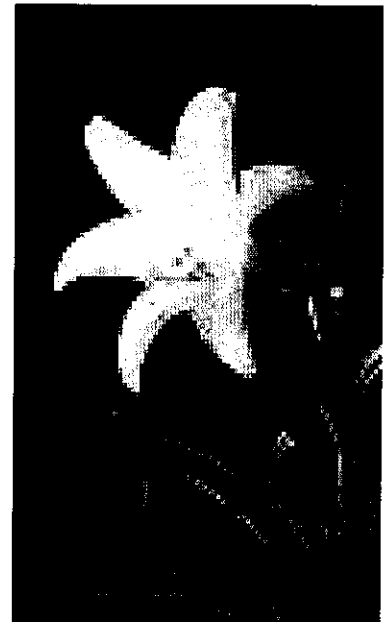
Hey Spartans!

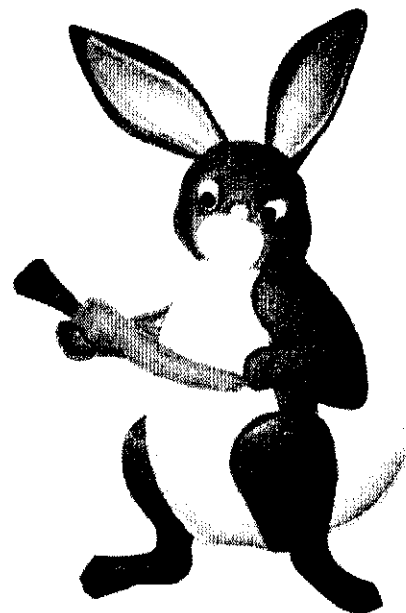
